

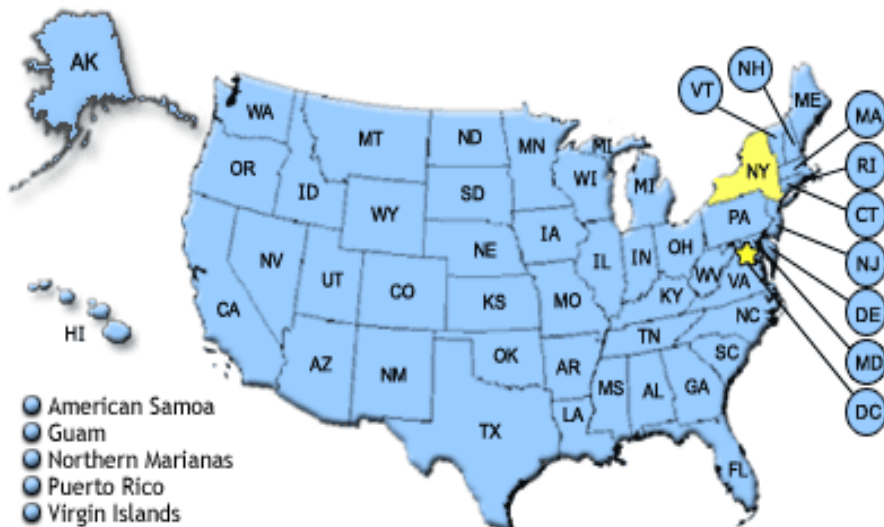
Hazardous Materials (HM) - Overview
