



Traffic Enforcement Activity

This report presents a breakdown of traffic enforcement inspection and violation activity for the selected year. The report can be filtered by fiscal or calendar years, carrier domicile, vehicle type, and violation type. Clicking on any column heading will sort the report by the selected column. By default, the report displays the inspections and violations by violation category for all vehicle types for the last 5 calendar years.

June 2020 – FMCSA has changed the way traffic enforcement inspections are counted. The methodology now includes violations in two **SMS BASICS**, some additional speeding violations not found in SMS, and inspection records flagged as traffic enforcements by the officer.

Filter Options

Filter	Description
Domicile	Carrier domicile is determined at the time of the event. 1) All domiciles : Carriers domiciled in the United States, Mexico, and Canada. 2) United States : Carriers domiciled in the United States. 3) Mexico : Carriers domiciled in Mexico. 4) Canada : Carriers domiciled in Canada.
Vehicle Type	By default, the filter will be set to 'All Vehicles'. You can select one of the 8 following options in this filter: 1) All Vehicles 2) All Trucks 3) All Passengers 4) Bus 5) Motorcoach 6) Limousine 7) School Bus 8) Van
Report Focus	1) National is a summary of all States' data and the U.S. territories. 2) Service Center is the region in which the carrier is located. 3) All States includes all States and the U.S. territories. 4) State includes one State's data. 5) Territory includes one Territory's data.
Time Period	Fiscal or Calendar year(s) when events occurred.

Column Name	Description
Total Number of Traffic Enforcement Inspections	Sum of Driver observed and Vehicle observed inspections
Number of Traffic Enforcement Inspections (Driver observed)	The number of inspections conducted as a result of a traffic enforcement stop where a violation is cited from the Unsafe Driving or Controlled Substances & Alcohol SMS BASICS, 392.2S (speeding), or 392.2SLLS1 (1-5 MPH over limit).
With Moving Violations	The number of traffic enforcement inspections conducted that resulted in one or more violations from the Unsafe Driving BASIC (excluding railroad crossing violations) or the 392.2S (speeding) or 392.2SLLS1 (1-5 MPH over limit) violation.
With Drug & Alcohol Violations	The number of traffic enforcement inspections conducted that resulted in one or more violations from the Controlled Substances & Alcohol BASIC.
With Railroad Crossing Violations	The number of traffic enforcement inspections conducted that resulted in one or more railroad crossing violations from the Unsafe Driving BASIC.
Number of Traffic Enforcement Inspections (Vehicle observed)	The number of inspections conducted as a result of a traffic enforcement stop (not counted in the driver observed category) where the record's traffic enforcement flag is checked.
Total Number of Traffic Enforcement Violations	Sum of Driver observed and Vehicle observed violations
Number of Traffic Enforcement Violations (Driver observed)	The total number of traffic enforcement violations from the Unsafe Driving or Controlled Substances & Alcohol SMS BASICS, 392.2S (speeding), or 392.2SLLS1 (1-5 MPH over limit).
Moving Violations	The total number of violations from the Unsafe Driving BASIC (excluding railroad crossing violations) or the 392.2S (speeding) or 392.2SLLS1 (1-5 MPH over limit) violation.
Drug & Alcohol Violations	The total number of violations from the Controlled Substances & Alcohol BASIC.



Enforcement Programs

Railroad Crossing Violations	The total number of railroad crossing violations from the Unsafe Driving BASIC.
Number of Traffic Enforcement Violations (Vehicle observed)	The total number of violations as a result of a traffic enforcement stop (not counted in the driver observed category) where the record's traffic enforcement flag is checked.

The traffic enforcement program is based on state or local traffic enforcement violations noted in conjunction with a roadside inspection.
